THE MAIN IDEA of the Youth Economic Forum is to set up the platform for discussing the theoretical issues and designing the practical mechanisms for the development of regions in the global economic space.

Since most regions of the world are governed by common developmental patterns, the Forum shall raise the most relevant issues related to the influence of the global economy on regional development and the formation of the prerequisites for sustainable development of the regions.

Since 2008, the event has been attended by more than 1 000 young researchers and specialists from Russia, Germany, Italy, Poland, Finland, Latvia, Tajikistan, Ukraine, Armenia and Azerbaijan. Its features are rapid change and high productivity, wide spread of information technology in all spheres of life. The new economy changes the traditional understanding of markets, entrepreneurship and the role of the state. Then new economy creates new opportunities for sustainable development of regions.

The forum will include three dimensions from which the list of thematic sessions, round tables, lectures and master classes follows:

- Scientific: research into processes of the new economy formation;
- Educational: generation of new knowledge on the Forum's subject matter;

• Practical: dissemination of experience based on entrepreneurial and managerial success stories.
