

# Preliminary accepted curriculum of the MA Programme in Environmental Management in the Arctic

#### 1 sem.:

- Environmental Management. 10 ECTS (MSTU);
- Arctic Ecology. 10 ECTS (including 3 ECTS of Philosophy of Natural Science) (MSHU);
- Environmental Risk and Reliability. 10 ECTS (UiT and NArFU as a contributing partner);

#### 2 sem.:

- Technology and Innovation. 5 ECTS (NArFU);
- Foreign Language. 5 ECTS (NArFU will be responsible for teaching Norwegian and MSHU – for teaching Russian);
- Environmental Monitoring. 5 ECTS (NArFU);
- Environmental Auditing. 5 ECTS (MSTU);
- Arctic Law. 5 ECTS (NArFU);
- International Cooperation. 5 ECTS (UiT).

3 and 4 sem.: Master Thesis. 60 ECTS.

- 4. Law of the sea in the arctic: continental shelf, fishery.
- 5. Law of the sea in the arctic: Northern Sea Route, transportation.
- 6. Concept of biological diversity: legal foundation (Russia and Norway).
- 7. Summary of the course.

#### **Arctic Law**

#### Description of the thematic content of lectures

- Introduction into the course "Arctic Law" with the delineation of all purposes and aims which were established by the course-makers. Proposals and outcomes of the course. Observation of general aspects of modern international public law: definition, system, legal sources, actors, interplays with domestic law, a role in international relations, relating to the Arctic.
- 2. Environmental law as the sub-branch of international public law. The concept of "sustainable development" and "environmental justice" in environmental law.
- 3. The role of indigenous communities in developing legal standards of environmental law. Interaction between international environmental norms and rights of indigenous peoples in the Arctic. Judicial cases.



#### **Arctic Law**

- 4. International law of the sea regime in the Arctic. Exploration and exploitation of continental shelf in the Arctic. Fishery issues in the Arctic.
- 5. International law of the sea regime in the Arctic and quaere on the Northern Sea Route. Transportation in the Arctic.
- 6. Concept of "biological diversity" in Norway and Russia: legal definition, legal sources, state programs.
- 7. Summary of the course: general conclusions, perspectives, suggestions.
