

Rasmus Bertelsen, Professor of Northern Studies, Department of Sociology, Political Science and Community Planning, UiT Arctic University of Norway, Tromsø. He is an international relations scholar who - in line with Rasmus Ole Rasmussen - has a deep personal and professional commitment to the High North. Rasmus' areas of research include historical and current transnational flows of knowledge, talent and financial resources between societies; science diplomacy; the role of the Arctic in transforming international order as well as transnational mobility in Arctic regions. Rasmus is involved with the project *The Academic (Un)employment at the Arctic North -project* funded by the Interreg Nord. The project targets academic cross-border mobility and networking among Northern academic labor force which is in precarian and vulnerable position, which benefits from mobility and which plays a major role in the well-being of the region. The key partners of the project teams are from the universities of Oulu, Luleå and Tromsø.
