Sunnari has researched, and organized and supervised research of matters related to gender, its intersections and equality, and of matters related to (non)violence specifically in comprehensive and university education since late 1980s. Human vulnerability and vulnerability of other living bodies are close to her interest areas recently as are matters of relationality, response-ability, sustainability and feminist posthuman ethics. She has authored numerous scientific journal articles, led numerous projects and supervised several doctoral, master and candidate theses. She has been actively involved with Nordic, Barents and Circumpolar network and collaboration. Her recent project commitments have been with Eige (European Institute for Gender Equality) and Interreg Nord project *Academic (un)employment and mobility in the Arctic North* and she is a responsible leader of nationwide teacher education project *SetSTOP – Developing contents for teacher education in Finland related to gender equality*.
